MAIN THING

One Of Satan's Greatest Victories Has Been Keeping The Church Ignorant Of God's Word

SCRIPTURE

Ephesians 6:13-17, 2 Timothy 3:16-17, Deuteronomy 6:5-9

ICEBREAKER

My favorite verse of Scripture is

OPENING THOUGHT

"Knowledge is power," we hear people say all the time. Our power comes from the word of God, the Scriptures. If we don't know what the Scripture says then how can we know what we are told to do as Christians? Satan loves an ignorant Christian, because an ignorant Christian equals a lukewarm Christian and it makes Satan's job easier. DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What was the one thing that you heard this past Sunday that stuck out to you? Why did it resonate with you like it did?
2. We read in Ephesians 6: 13-17 to put on the armor of God, but as we continue to read the only weapon is the "Sword of the Spirit" or "The word of God". How can we best equip ourselves to use this "weapon" against evil?
3. We see in 2 Timothy 3: 16-17 that we use God's word for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness. Out of those four, which one do you see most present in your life? Are you doing it correctly?

LIFE APPLICATION

Knowing what God says is so important to the life of a Christian. Without knowing what the scripture says it is very easy for us to think we are doing right, that we are doing what God wants, but it's really us being deceived by Satan which makes us slightly deviate from God. Question- how can we make learning and using the scripture correctly a part of our lives daily?

CHALLENGE

It is so important to not only know what the Word of God says for yourself, but to pass it along and train up the next generation of Christians; our kids. We are their number one role models, and if we don't raise them with a "Christ first" mentality the world will raise them with a "world (themselves) first" mentality. We need to be able to properly raise up the next generation. Make learning scripture, and being a "God first" family a priority in your everyday life if it already isn't.
